### THE TENSION

<sup>36</sup>But when He (Jesus) saw the multitudes, He was moved with compassion for them, because they were weary and scattered, like sheep having no shepherd. --Matthew 9:36 NKJV

moved with compassion: splagchnon (splangkh'-non); from the intestines or bowels; sympathy; inward affection, tender mercy.

- JESUS CARED MORE THAN ANYONE WHO HAS EVER LIVED.
- JESUS DID NOT HEAL EVERYONE OR GRANT EVERY REQUEST.

#### HELPING WITHOUT ENABLING

#### 1) OFFER WHAT THEY NEED, NOT WHAT THEY WANT.

<sup>6</sup>Then Peter said, "Silver or gold I do not have, but what I do have I give you. In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, walk."

<sup>7</sup>Taking him by the right hand, he helped him up... --Acts 3:6-7 NIV

- Identify the real need.
- Pay attention to actions, not words.

## 2) SET HEALTHY BOUNDARIES.

<sup>35</sup>Very early in the morning, while it was still dark, Jesus got up, left the house and went off to a solitary place, where He prayed. <sup>36</sup>Simon and his companions went to look for Him, <sup>37</sup>and when they found Him, they exclaimed: "Everyone is looking for You!" --Mark 1:35-37 NIV

- Time boundaries
- Resource boundaries

## 3) ALLOW THEM TO FACE THEIR CONSEQUENCES.

<sup>7</sup>Don't be misled—you cannot mock the justice of God. You will always harvest what you plant. <sup>8</sup>Those who live only to satisfy their own sinful nature will harvest decay and death from that sinful nature. But those who live to please the Spirit will harvest everlasting life from the Spirit. --Galatians 6:7-8 NLT

- Rescuing isn't always helping.
- Jesus is the Savior, not you.
