### **BREAKING THE POWER OF MANIPULATION**

### 1. RECOGNIZE WHEN SOMEONE IS TRYING TO CONTROL YOU.

<sup>21</sup>From that time on Jesus began to explain to His disciples that He must go to Jerusalem and suffer many things at the hands of the elders, the chief priests and the teachers of the law, and that He must be killed and on the third day be raised to life. <sup>22</sup>Peter took him aside and began to rebuke Him. "Never, Lord!" he said. "This shall never happen to You!" --Matthew 16:21-22 NIV

• Manipulators lose power in groups. Some do it unintentionally. Peter didn't mean any harm, but just wanted his plan for Jesus' life.

#### 2. VERBALIZE AND SHOW THAT THIS IS NOT GOING TO WORK ON ME.

<sup>23</sup>Jesus turned and said to Peter, "Get behind Me, Satan! You are a stumbling block to Me; you do not have in mind the concerns of God, but merely human concerns." --Matthew 16: 23 NIV

### **3. REDEFINE** THE RELATIONSHIP.

Jesus allowed Peter to fail

<sup>16</sup>Again Jesus said, "Simon son of John, do you love Me?" He answered, "Yes, Lord, You know that I love you." Jesus said, "Take care of My sheep." --John 21:16 NIV

<sup>10</sup>Obviously, I'm not trying to win the approval of people, but of God. If pleasing people were my goal, I would not be Christ's servant. --Galatians 1:10 NLT
